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Requirements	B1+/B2 level minimum in English. You should be able to participate in a course that is fully conducted in English, and present some research material in English
Agenda	9-12 am / 2-5pm Lunch and evening meals will be opportunities to practice small talk. <b>Day 1:</b> Introducing one another, describing your field of research (mini presentations), presenting your laboratory. Methodology for effective scientific writing (depending of participants' needs) <b>Day 2:</b> Describing graphs and trends, structuring your presentation, storytelling, question & answer sessions  A visit in English (understanding a different accent and interacting with the guide)  <b>Day 3:</b> speaking at a conference – practice and feedback, including Q&A questions. Networking with local colleagues, Organizing and participating in a meeting, cross-cultural differences.
